Au-Quartz veins in historical Ymir Camp

Tenure: 1123731

Area: 189.58 Ha

The Ymir Project is located 10 kilometres northeast of Ymir on the northwest flank of Mount Dundee. The elevation is around 5000 feet. The claim covers the Garfield, Twilight, Sunrise, Sundown, Sundown Fraction, Morning Star No. 3, Morning Star No. 2, North Star Fraction and Two Star Fraction Crown Grants (All reverted).

The Garfield Crown Grant was crown-granted in 1904 with development since then consisting of one "very short" tunnel, a 3-metre shaft and four or five open cuts. On the Garfield there are several veins. The East Vein outcrops at several points and at least two other veins show. It is not clear whether one of them is the West vein of the Little George Crown Grant or not. The other vein is a spur four or five feet wide, striking off into the granite. It is on this vein that the shaft has been sunk.

A sample taken on 1.2 metres of quartz in an opencut on the Garfield claim yielded 9.6 grams per tonne gold and 54.86 grams per tonne silver.

Ruby silver (pyrargyrite) has been reported as well as traces of tetrahedrite on the western side of the property.
